

Notes/Instructions for 2010-11 Scout & Adult Registrations

Please return your completed 2010-11 Registration Form, 2010/11 Vehicle Information Form (if you will be transporting any scouts to any activities/trips this year) and check for annual registration fees by delivering them at a regular troop meeting to the scoutmaster or committee chairman or via mail to Cynthia Cook, 2415 Bugle Lane, Reston, VA 20191. **COMPLETED FORMS/CHECKS SHOULD BE RETURNED BY NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, OCTOBER 15, 2010.** If you have any questions, please contact Cynthia Cook at 703-391-7414 or e-mail at c96t44ac66k@hotmail.com.

***IMPORTANT CHANGE FOR ADULT REGISTRATIONS 2010-11: Effective June 1, 2010, Youth Protection training is required for all registered volunteers. Youth Protection training must be taken every two years. If a volunteer's Youth Protection training record is not current at the time of re-charter, the volunteer will not be re-registered. Please make sure that you list the date of your Youth Protection training on the attached form.**

If you have not taken Youth Protection training within the past two years, please log on to www.myscouting.org and take the training. Be sure to have your member ID number. The number can be found on your Boy Scouts of America membership card. If you do not know your member ID number, contact your scoutmaster or committee chairman.

New volunteers are required to take Youth Protection training before they submit an application for registration. The certificate of completion for this training must be submitted at the time application is made and before volunteer service with youth begins.

A person does not have to be a registered volunteer or have an ID number to take Youth Protection training. To take the training, log in to www.myscouting.org and create an account. From the MyScouting portal, click on E-Learning and take the Youth Protection training. Upon completion, print a certificate and submit it with your BSA adult application.

If you previously have taken Youth Protection training online but did not input your member ID number, please log on to www.myscouting.org and input your member ID in the My Profile section so the training will be linked to your records. If you have taken Youth Protection training but did not take the course online, log on to www.myscouting.org to ensure your records are up-to-date.

****Annual registration fees cover BSA registration, troop insurance, and troop expenses such as advancement materials (troop patches, merit badges, merit badge books, rank badges, etc.), newsletter expenses, Boy's Life magazine, supplies, required adult training, and partial coverage of expense of adult registration at summer camp for the Scout year from September 2010 to August 2011. NOT INCLUDED in the fee are uniform expenses or the red Class B Troop 1970 T-shirt.**
